

Title I Parent and Family Engagement Plan Enoch Elementary 2020- 2021

Enoch Elementary is committed to providing a quality education to *all* students at the school. We realize it takes the involvement of parents, administrators, teachers, and paraprofessionals to close the achievement gap for *all* students. The faculty and staff at Enoch Elementary encourage questions, communication and input on your students.

We at Enoch have an active Community Council and PTA. The goal of both groups is to help raise the academic standards of our students. Along with providing assistance with developing a budget for our Trustland monies, the Community Council serves as the committee for math and reading incentives to encourage all students to reach their class reading and math goals. The Community Council reviews the yearly School Wide Title I Plan for Enoch Elementary. Enoch has two parents who attend the fall and spring district Title I meetings.

The PTA provides a monthly newsletter to all parents with all up coming events in the school. The newsletter also includes an article from our school administrator each month.

The PTA sponsors a book fair twice yearly during SEP(Student Education Plan) weeks for the students. During SEP week, the parents are given an update on their student's progress and RISE (Readiness Improvement Success Empowerment) testing is reviewed with the parents and students.

In the spring of each year, the school provides a Kindergarten registration for incoming Kindergarten students. At this time students are screened for any health problems, and parents receive information about academic readiness. Teachers are also made aware of a student who will be transitioning from an Even Start, Head Start, or district pre-school to our school and a transition meeting is scheduled between the two schools.

Teachers communicate weekly with parents via newsletter, e-mail or a texting application such as Remind 101 to keep the parents informed of ways they can help their students at home during the week, as well as upcoming events. The school provides a newsletter to the local newspaper, once a week, telling of upcoming and past events at Enoch Elementary.

This Family Engagement Policy will be evaluated through the "ICSD Parent Survey" distributed to every parent during the spring SEP conferences. Parents will have the opportunity to voice concerns, make suggestions for improvement, and compliment the school for the programs offered at the school.
